The global Expedition will depart in late 2022 for a period of over 12 months and will be showcasing the latest positive technologies and science throughout the journey.

The Expedition will be used to test the latest technology innovations in

the remotest and most hostile regions and with some of the most marginal communities in the world.

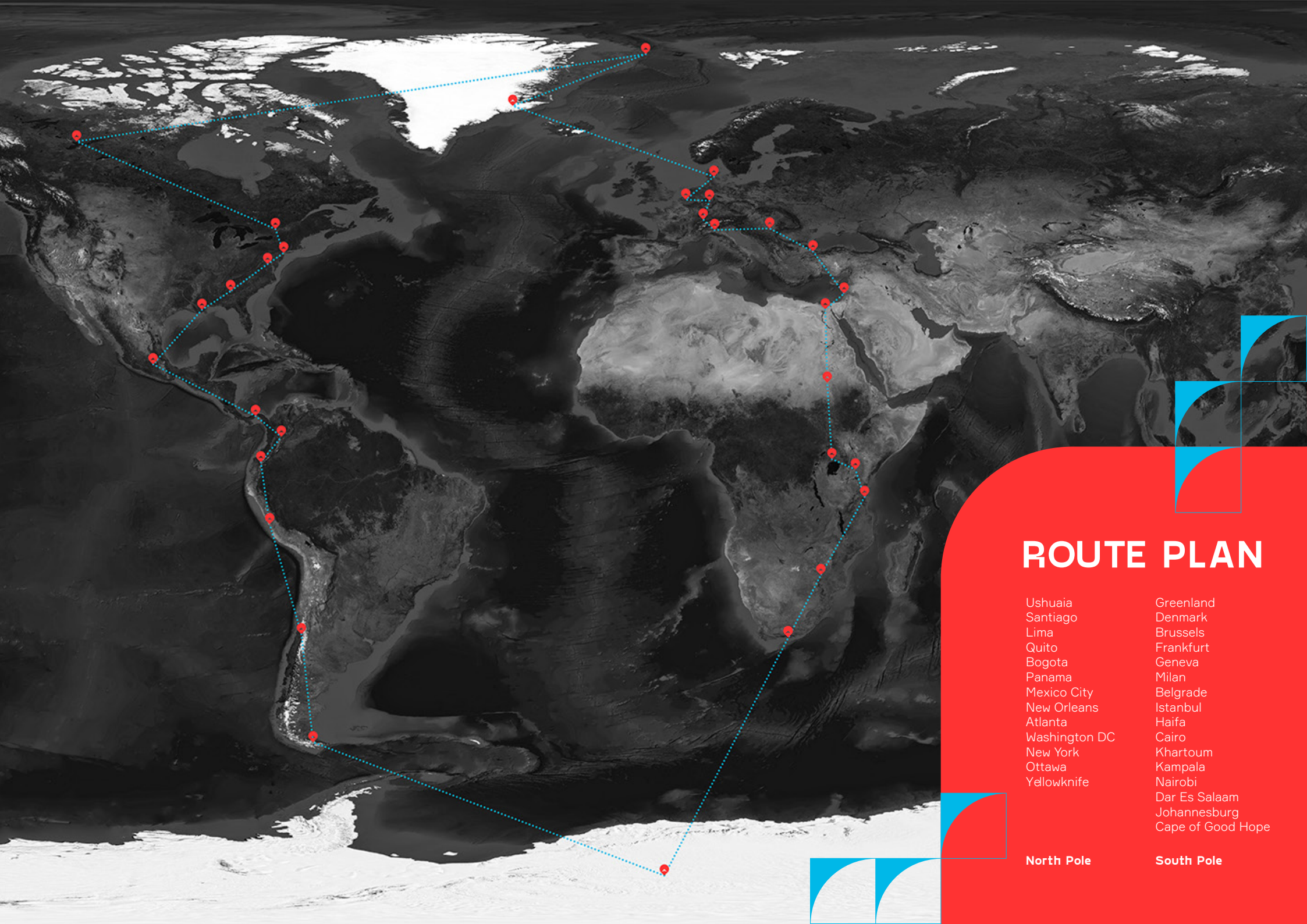
Value

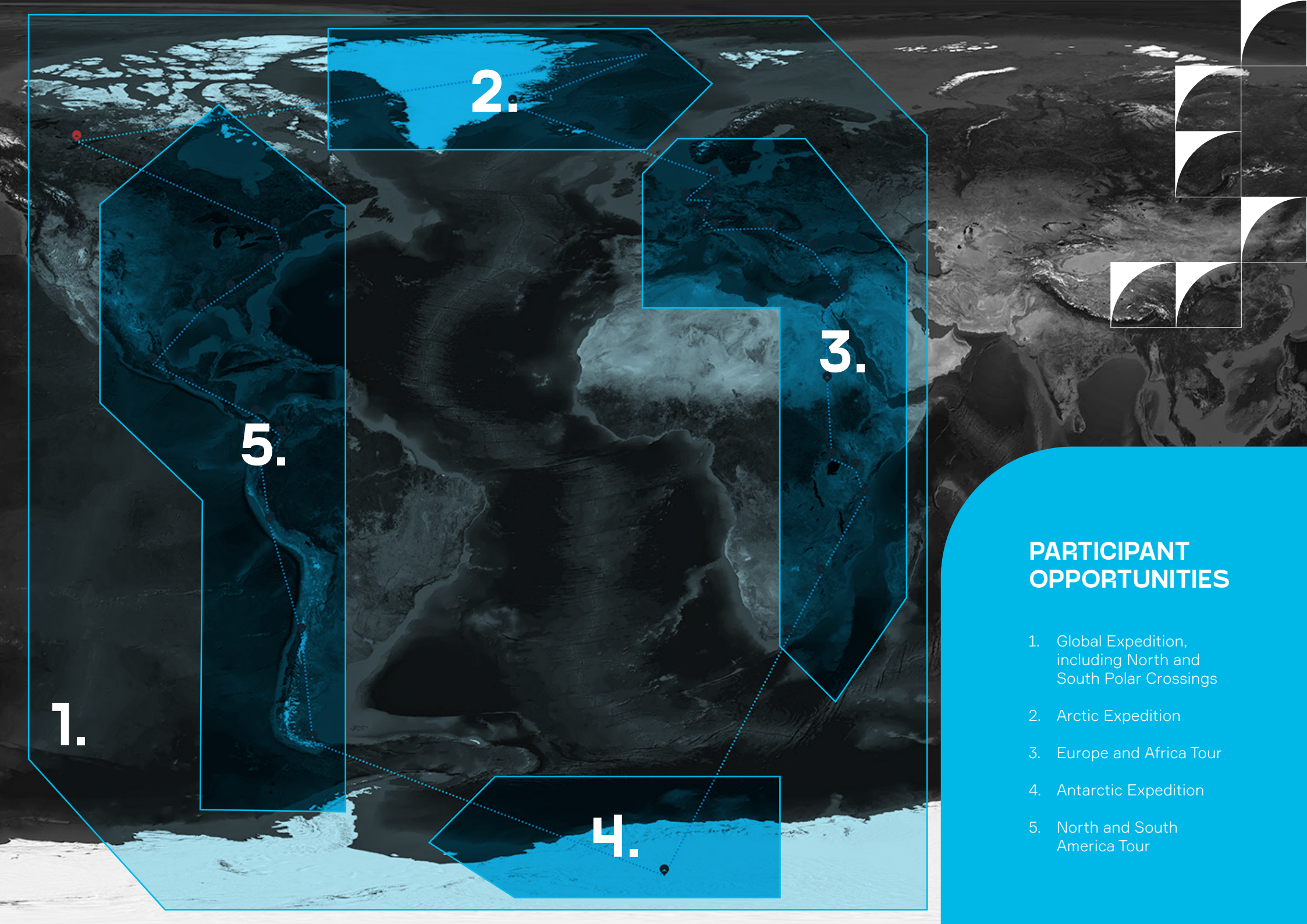

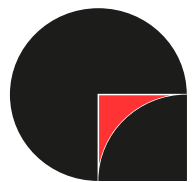
